







Trip Size Policy

throughout the trip.



Ski tours use a classification system to describe the skiing skills and stamina required for participation in a trip. If you are unsure whether your skiing abilities (especially turning and

stopping skills) are suitable for a trip, please contact the trip leader. Easy I: 1 to 3 miles round trip on generally flat terrain. Suitable for beginners.

Moderate II: 1100 ft. to 1500 ft. elevation gain. Moderate III: 1500 ft. to 1800 ft. elevation gain.

Winter Trip Classifications

Easy II: 3 to 6 miles round trip and up to 600 ft. elevation gain. Easy III: 6 to 8 miles round trip or 600 ft. to 800 ft. elevation gain. Moderate I: 800 ft. to 1100 ft. elevation gain.

Cross country ski trip classifications:

Advanced I: 1800 ft. to 2500 ft. elevation gain, 15-20 miles. Advanced II: Over 2500 ft. elevation gain. Snowshoe trip classifications:
