# Tour of the Colorado State Capitol Building:


Tuesday March12, 2024, at 1pm. Location: 200 E. Colfax, Denver <u>Register here</u>

This private tour will be led by our own Mary Bradley (CMC staff member and Capital Volunteer) and should take about 1 to 1.5 hours. The Colorado State Capitol was constructed in the 1890s with Colorado white granite and



topped with its distinctive gold dome. The dome itself is covered in copper panels that are gilded with gold leaf from a Colorado mine. The gold was first added in 1908 to commemorate the Colorado Gold Rush. Optional Happy Hour following the tour at the beautiful outdoor bar (weather permitting) at <u>The Art Hotel</u> <u>Denver</u> Curio Collection by Hilton , 1201 Broadway, Denver. If the weather is poor, we'll be inside.

#### Tour of the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) in Boulder:



April 25th at 1:00. Registration details will be in the March newsletter.

Nestled below the flat irons in Boulder, The NCAR building is considered an architectural marvel. Affiliated with the University of Colorado, NCAR is known for world class research in earth system science. We will have a private tour to learn more about their invaluable research.

Did any of you shoe on those super cold January days? Weather warming up as of this writing, but boy, was it cold!!
