Jennifer Roach!

"A flatlander transformed into a mountain climber." Jennifer Roach was born in Chicago and transplanted to Colorado at age 27. She joined the CMC Denver Group in 1981 and never had a doll or an active weekend thereafter. Jennifer remained active with the Denver Group for many years as a participant and trip leader and served on the Denver Group council and was in charge of the group activity schedule for a full 7 years.

Jennifer has climbed all of Colorado's 14ers and 13ers as well as 3/4 of Colorado's 12ers, numerous 11ers and so on

down the line.

Outside of Colorado, Jennifer has climbed numerous peaks in the entire Western US, both wellknown and obscure. In 2003, she completed the fabled desert peaks section list of the Sierra Club. Add to this some international climbs in Central and South America, the UK and several other countries. Now you have a flatlander transformed!
