BKPS Overview

BKPS has over twenty (20) volunteer instructors who share their knowledge and experiences on how to backpack safely in the Colorado mountains in non-winter conditions. We are all committed to help you gain the skills you desire, whether you're just starting out, rusty with your skills and need a refresher, or want to learn the latest in backpacking!

While we have around fifty (50) students who sign up for the course each year, we assign students to Small Groups. Each Small Group is lead by a Group Leader, with one (1) to two (2) additional BKPS instructors, and eight (8) students.

BKPS Curriculum

The BKPS curriculum is offered in a hybrid format:

- Student-Led Learning Students complete general preparation, on-line learning modules, and reading <u>on their own</u> <u>schedule but prior to the instructor-led training (ILT) date!</u>
- Instructor-Led Training "In person" [AMC, Virtual, and Field] interaction with BKPS instructors.
