

Alpine Scrambling Course

Alpine scrambling is defined as unroped climbing over mountainous terrain. The Denver Group's Alpine Scrambling Course (ASC) consists of self-guided online learning, 3 online weekday evening lectures, one inperson meetup (weekday evening), a Student Skills Field Day (Snow Travel and Scrambling Skills), and 2 progressive Scramble Field Days.



There is strong emphasis on route-finding and teamwork throughout the course. ASC will require a significant time commitment over May and June. It's well worth it! This is a popular course that always fills up.

The application process has two steps:

- Complete the Online Course Application (opens March 1st)
- Wait for confirmation of your acceptance into the course, then register for the course via the website (enroll/pay tuition.)

Winter Camping School is for CMC members statewide who want to comfortably enjoy winter, while learning new skills and staying safe and warm. This school is recommended not only for backpackers, but anyone who intends to spend extended time in the backcountry in winter conditions, including snowshoers/skiers, mountaineers, and ice climbers.

WCS covers topics like how to dress, traveling efficiently, setting up camp, cooking, and sleeping comfortably.

The school will start on Tuesday, February 13th, at 6:20 PM. Registration is open now and will close on Feb 12th at midnight. Register <u>HERE</u>. Be sure to read all of the details and follow all instructions.

Attendance at all lectures is mandatory, with 2 required overnight trips.

Tuition is \$110 for Denver Group members and \$120 for other CMC members.

Wilderness Trekking School (WTS) is for all – whether you want to bag a few 14ers or just want to enjoy the scenery. Students are adults of all ages, and it's the CMC's most popular school. It's a comprehensive course on mountain day-hiking, with no prerequisites.

If you're new to hiking, WTS provides an opportunity to learn how to travel safely and confidently in the backcountry. If you're already an experienced hiker, it gives you a chance to review and enhance your skills and maybe fill in some gaps.

WTS is a requirement for the Backpacking School and Alpine Climbing School.

Learn and practice new skills, make new friends, and become a safer, more confident backcountry traveler!

Tuition is \$170 until March 25 for current CMC Members, and \$190 thereafter. **Registration is open now on the course website.**
