

Backcountry Nordic Ski School (BNSS)

Registration for the Backcountry Nordic Ski School is now open! <u>Sign up</u> for the on-line zoom meeting on December 5 and three field trips held during the first three weeks of January on Wednesdays, Saturdays, or Sundays.

Learn the nuances of Nordic skiing in the backcountry. Experience Colorado's finest snow, away from the crowds and lift tickets! Learn to cross-country ski and get prepared for backcountry trails using classic Nordic-style technique. (No AT or Telemark gear is allowed in this school.) We accommodate students from never-evers to those who have skied for years. Classes are often less than ten students with a minimum of two instructors.

Beginner Snowshoe School

One-day sessions now open for <u>registration</u>!

Learn about snowshoe selection and fit, appropriate dress and keeping warm, prepping for a trip, trail techniques, breaking trail, and fall recovery.

If demand cannot be satisfied with this schedule, we'll add more sessions. We urge you to sign up for the earliest session that works for you so you can enjoy the CMC's regular snowshoe trips for the rest of the 2024 winter season.


On October 11th, we said good-bye to our dear friend and outstanding volunteer John Walters.
