Welcome to the WSG's New Conservation Chair, Claire McCullough!

Claire was voted in as the new WSG Conservation Chair at our Annual Dinner on October 14. We're happy that Claire is joining us on the WSG Council! She shared her background with us:

"I grew up in northern Colorado and began hiking with my dad in Rocky Mountain National Park when I was 5 years old. Thirty years ago, I moved to the Western Slope. I have been involved with various conservation issues. I was an appointed member of the Colorado Northwest Resource Advisory Council – part of a 15-member council providing the BLM with recommendations on public land management issues. I participated in the field study of resource values of several BLM Wilderness Study Areas in the Grand Junction and Craig districts, providing citizen input to the BLM. I worked with a local rancher and an environmental group to reach an agreement that led to the legislative designation of the Black Ridge Canyons Wilderness Area. I currently live in Grand Junction and enjoy hiking, Nordic skiing and tending to my micro flower farm. For printed inspiration about the value of nature, I read the works of Aldo Leopold, Terry Tempest Williams and Edward Abbey."

- 2) Scroll down the page and click on "Edit Profile".
- 3) Scroll down the page to "Alerts and Notifications Preferences" and select your desired "Update Frequency". You'll also need to choose at least one activity.
- 4) Scroll down the page and click on "Save".
