# Revised GMUG FS Revised Forest Plan and Comment Period

The Forest Service has published a revised Grand Mesa Uncompany and Gunnison National Forests (GMUG) forest plan and final environmental impact statement. <u>This legal notice</u> was published in the Grand Junction Daily Sentinel on August 30 and indicates there's a 60-day objection filing period. This is an FYI to keep our members informed of this revised GMUG plan.

# Website FAQ: "How do I find out about new trips after they're posted?"

The new website has a nice feature where you can get notified of new trips when they're added or in a daily digest or in a weekly digest. Here's the steps for setting that up.

1) Login to your CMC account and click on "My Profile" under your name on the upper right.

2) Scroll down the page and click on "Edit Profile".

3) Scroll down the page to "Alerts and Notifications Preferences" and select your desired "Update Frequency". You'll also need to choose at least one activity.

4) Scroll down the page and click on "Save".
