Antigua: Hike the Pacaya Volcano

February 18, 2024

Depart the hotel at 8:00 am and travel approximately 1.5 hours to the trail head of Pacaya Volcano. Located in Pacaya national park it is a storybook volcano with a continuous plume of smoke drifting from its summit. There is a massive dried lava field forming in the valley at the base of the caldera. We will hike through the rugged dried lava fields recently reformed by a massive eruption in 2010.

Depending on conditions we will stop for a freshly prepared picnic lunch while enjoying the views of the nearby volcanoes of Agua, Fuego, and Acatenango. And possibly roast some marshmallows in warm lava rock pockets. Following lunch we will return to the trail head and travel back to Antigua

Day 4

After breakfast, head out for a mountain biking exploration of the Antigua area. The group will be divided in two depending on ability and comfort level. Then we will depart Antigua on cobblestone and dirt roads towards Volcan Agua and San Juan del Obispo.

We will bike through agricultural fields, coffee farms, avocado trees and traverse across the lower sections of Volcan De Agua with great views of Antigua and the rest of the valley. The downhill ride will bring us to the village of San Pedro las Huertas and then we cruise back to Antigua.

Day 5 Antigua to Acatenango Camp

Feb 20,2024

At 8:00 am we will travel to the village of La Soledad where we will begin the hike up Acatenango Volcano. The route has four micro climates. The first is farmland and is the same path used by villagers to reach their crops. The second passes through old growth, high alpine cloud forest which is the home to many exotic birds, including the Quetzal. Here we stop for a picnic lunch.

Temperate and tropical forests characterize the third climate. The fourth climate is the storm beaten tree line of the volcano. Just below tree line, at 12,300 feet is where we will camp. Relax, take in the views, as dinner is being prepared for you.

Depending on weather conditions, rise early and enjoy the sunrise over the volcano peaks. Then we will hike approximately 1 hour up a steep gravel trail through a pine forest, which leads to the windy summit of Acatenango Peak at 13043 ft. At the summit enjoy the 360 degree view of the Guatemalan highlands stretching all the way to Mexico.

After a return to camp, we will eat breakfast, and break camp. On the three hour descent we will follow a different trail so we can enjoy some new beautiful scenery on the way down. Transport will be waiting at the trail head to take us back to Antigua.
