In 2025, the Bobcats led 124 trips—a 38% increase over 2024—guided by 26 volunteer trip leaders and joined by nearly 900 participants. Participant feedback was overwhelmingly positive, highlighting exceptional leadership, strong camaraderie, thoughtful decision-making, and consistently memorable mountain experiences.


